Featuring bronze bushes fitted to the tow flange for longer

life and easy removal of the yoke, the range also features an extended collar lower bush with more 'bearing' surface on the tow pin.

The Pacific Series also incorporates a re-profiled flange that prevents the rubber cushions from squeezing out from under the load or allowing excess shunting, and has a stronger nylon wear pad for extended service life.

During a visit to Australia last year, V.Orlandi Managing Director Gianpietro Mascialino said: "We have worked for over a decade to build a range that is specific to Australia. In fact, we made sure that before anything was ever introduced onto Australian roads it perfectly suited the conditions.
